“The Second Malta Conference in Graph Theory and Combinatorics,” held between the 26th and 30th June 2017 in Qawra, Malta, commemorates the 75th birthday of Professor Stanley Fiorini. The first conference was organized by Stanley Fiorini and Josef Lauri in 1990 in Bugibba.

When submitting your paper, be sure to specify that the paper is a contribution for the Special Issue of **2MCGTC2017**. Please see the *Author Instructions* on the site. Also select the article type SI: **2MCGTC2017**.

The deadline for submission is **15th November 2017**.

Accepted papers will be published online individually, before print publication.
