Special Issue: 2nd Russian-Hungarian Combinatorial Workshop

We are preparing a special issue of the journal *Discrete Applied Mathematics* related to the 2nd *Russian-Hungarian Combinatorial Workshop*, held in the Rényi Institute (Budapest, Hungary), June 27-29, 2018. The aim of the workshop was to exchange ideas and intensify joint research. The 1st Russian-Hungarian Combinatorial Workshop took place in the Moscow Institute of Physics and Technology (Dolgoprudny, Russia).

The special issue will be based on extended versions of contributions presented at the workshop, but papers not presented there are also welcome. Both original research papers and well-written surveys can be submitted. Contributions arising from papers given at the workshop should be substantially extended, and should cite the workshop paper where appropriate.

All articles will be thoroughly refereed according to the high standards of *Discrete Applied Mathematics*.

The full papers must be submitted through the Elsevier Editorial System (<http://ees.elsevier.com/dam>). When submitting your paper, please specify that the paper is a contribution for the Special Issue devoted to the **2nd Russian-Hungarian Combinatorial Workshop**, so that your paper will be assigned to the guest editors. Please see the Author Instructions on the site if you have not yet submitted a paper through this web-based system. Be sure to select the article type **SI: 2nd Russ-Hung Combin.**

The deadline for submission is **November 30, 2018**.

Accepted papers will be published online individually, before print publication.
